


1. Person vs. Person


- ▶ External conflict between one character and another.
- ► Protagonist vs. Antagonist



2. Person vs. Society


External conflict when the protagonist has an issue with a large group or

3. Person vs. Nature

External conflict with a character working against nature.



4. Person vs. Self

▶ Internal conflict when the character is fighting against himself.



5. Person vs. Technology

External conflict with character facing machine/robot/technology


