#### 4 Sentence Types:



#### \_= 1 (or more) subordinate clause + 1 independent clause

Sub. clauses that start a sentence need a comma after them.

Sub. clauses that come in the middle or at the end of a sentence do NOT need a comma.

# = 1 (or more) subordinate clause + 2 (or more) independent clauses

Simple =

Compound-Complex = + + +
