GRAMMAR:

4 Sentence Types:

[] = 1 independent clause

- [] + [] + []
I like pizza.

[] = 2 (or more) independent clauses

- Can be joined with a [] and []
- Can be joined with a []

I like pizza, but I don't like cheese.

I like pizza; I don't like cheese.

= 1 (or more) subordinate clause + 1 independent clause

- Sub. clauses that start a sentence need a comma after them.

If I can pick the cheese off, I like pizza.

- Sub. clauses that come in the middle or at the end of a sentence do NOT need a comma.



I like pizza if I can pick the cheese off.



= 1 (or more) subordinate clause + 2 (or more) independent clauses

I like pizza if I can pick the cheese off, but if I can't, you can have mine.

Because I despise melted cheese, I threw the pizza at his head; he wasn't happy.

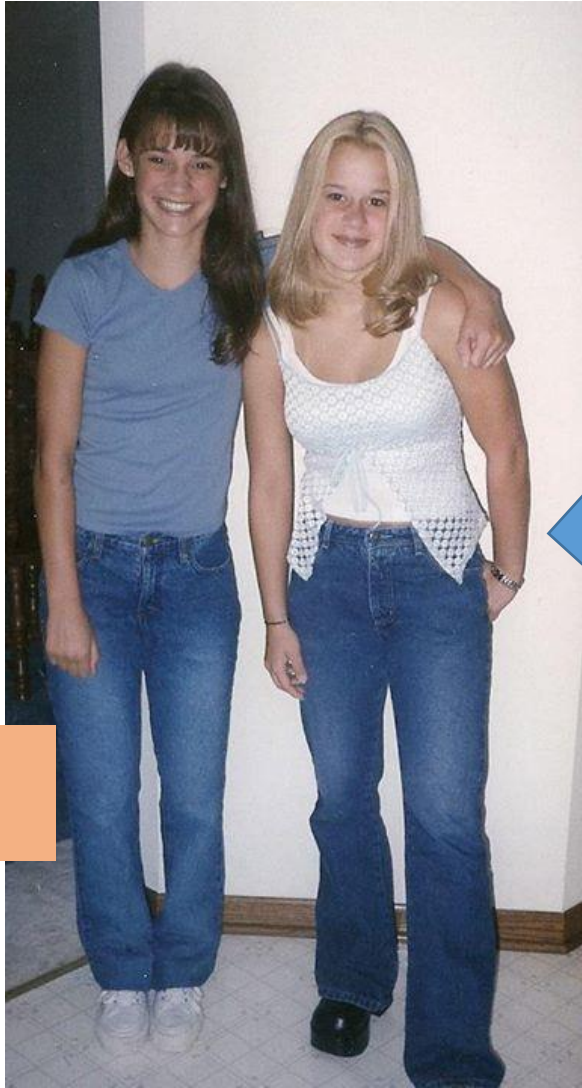
