


1. ANSWER: Does **NOT** use key words

2. ANSWER: Contains the **wrong** answer.

- Dynamic character: A character who **changes** in the story.
- One correct answer → Rainsford

3. PROOF: No quotes used.

- You cannot just summarize. You need **text evidence**.

Rainsford is a dynamic character in "The Most Dangerous Game." ~~*Rainsford thinks that there are two groups.*~~

BETTER:

Rainsford is a dynamic character in "The Most Dangerous Game." *"The world is made up of two classes: the hunters and the huntees."*

4. PROOF: Quotations are PLOPPED

- You must introduce **text evidence**.
