Mini-Project: Identity

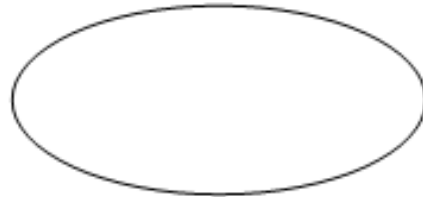
In this novel, the protagonist struggles with his identity. Your task is to create a cover for your novel packet.

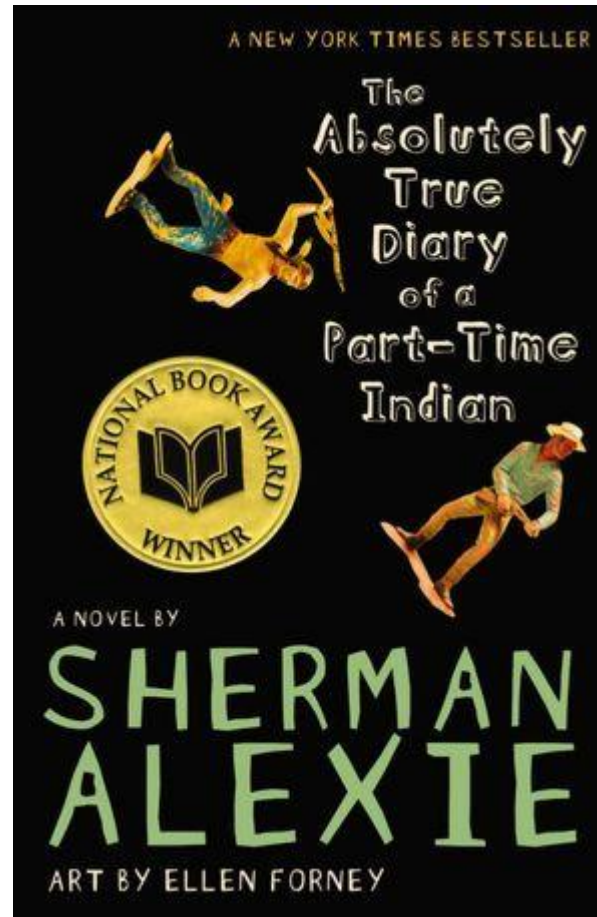
