

	HINT	EXAMPLE
Step 1 → Find the verb. Put a box around it.	Look for a linking verb OR an action verb.	Kanye Westneeds guidance.
Step 2→ Find the subject. Put a circle around it.	Whom/what is doing the action? Or whom/what is the sentence about?	Who needs? Kanye West needs guidance.
Step 3→ Read the sentence. ASK: Can it stand by itself?	Try adding "I think that…" before the phrase. If it makes sense, it IS a sentence!	<i>I think that</i> Kanye West needs guidance. YES! It's a sentence.
