Formatting Your Research

Option 1: Brochure

Choose “general,” not AISD

- You may construct the brochure yourself using paper, glue, markers, printouts, etc. or use a brochure template from Google Docs.
- Whatever you choose, it will eventually need to be a hard copy.

Option 2: Infographic

- Create a login at **canva.com** via Google+.
- Scroll down to Blogging and Ebooks and select “Infographic” as your template.

Option 3: TED Talk

- Use your outline to structure a transcript for your talk. You can find examples of TED talk transcripts at **ted.com/talks**.
- Remember, your video will be 3-5 minutes long. You will eventually need to upload it to a platform for viewing.

Rough Draft & Works Cited

- Next lesson → Bring in a mock-up of your research presentation **AND** your final Works Cited.
- Remember, this **AND** the creative component is due next week Monday/Tuesday!

Requirements for Research Component

Must contain:

- Thesis statement that answers the researchable question
- Information provided addresses
 - the extent of the problem
 - its effects
 - its causes
 - and potential solutions
- *At least* four reputable sources cited
- Works Cited section (MLA format)

Requirements for Creative Product

- Original work
- Typed reflection for display
 - Connects product to book
 - Connects product to research
 - Explains purpose of product
